Boyd Funds – Fine Arts Complex Fund Use and Recommendation

The Allan Hancock College Foundation (AHCF) received a gift of \$10 million+ from Patty Boyd, a former faculty member, with the intended purpose to support music and fine arts at the college. The AHCF allocated the gift into three separate funds. Based on the requirements set forth in the Patty Boyd bequest, as well as the initial clarifications set by the AHCF board of directors in 2013, the Executive and Finance Committees agree the proposed Fine Arts classroom/complex fully meets the intended wishes of the donor. The Executive Committee recommends approval of the Fine Arts classroom/complex and the allocation of the \$10 million+ gift from Patty Boyd by the AHCF board of directors. Director Owen reported that if the board of directors approves the recommendation, the Finance Committee would work closely with the District staff and investment partners on the appropriate distribution.

Endowment Scholarship & Program Funding 2017-2018

Director Owen reported the Finance Committee reviewed funding proposals for the scholarship and program endowments with the review date of November 30, 2017. The committee's recommendation is to fund 67 regular endowments for \$257,935, to fund Title III (\$18,050) and Non-Fed Title III (\$30,950) for \$49,000, and to fund quasi-endowments for \$48,239.

Marian Hancock Scholarship Endowment Award for May 2018

The Marian Hancock Scholarship considered the most prestigious scholarship provided by the AHCF each year. The scholarship honors the legacy of Mrs. Marian Hancock who started the award in the late 1960's. This year the endowment proceeds are \$5,950. Director Owen reported the Finance Committee recommends increasing the award for May 2018 to \$10,000, noting that the committee will determine the source of funding to augment the award. It was also recommended that this scholarship be reviewed annually to determine the award amount each year.

Hancock Promise Endowment Fund - Agreement with Santa Barbara Foundation

The Hancock Promise Endowment Campaign has a \$10 million goal to reach by 2021. More than \$2 million in pledges and direct donations has been received to date. Director Owen reported the Finance Committee discussed options to house these funds, including hearing a presentation from the Santa Barbara Foundation (SBF) last fall. The SBF provided two types of funds available to the AHCF – a long-term endowment fund or quasi-endowment. The SBF would serve as the investment advisor and be a significant community partner for the AHCF on the Hancock Promise. Director Owen shared the Finance Committee recommends approval of the partnership with the Santa Barbara Foundation to manage the Hancock Promise endowment. In addition,

the Finance Committee will identify investment preferences, negotiate fees and work with the District on the necessary contractual agreements.

40th Gala Budget Summary and Recommendation

Ms. Houghton reported that most expenses are paid and net revenues were approximately \$136,606, of which \$84,000 is specifically directed for the Hancock Promise endowment fund. That left approximately \$52,006 in unrestricted funding. The committee discussed options provided by staff. Following that discussion, the committee recommended funding the following: \$25,000 for the AIM Grant/Scholarship fund and \$27,006 for the cost and implementation associated with the Hancock Promise.

Community Ambassadors Committee

Hancock Promise Committee Report

Staff are finalizing commitments from annual donors for their participation this year as well. The annual scholarship event is set for Thursday, May 24, 2018, and based on the survey for the afternoon scholarship reception last May and discussion by the committee, the following is recommended for the annual scholarship event this year: that the event for 2018 be funded by the AHC Foundation with staff working with the Finance Committee to identify various revenue sources; that the event return to a dinner format; that student award winners and donors continue to bring one guest each, and the event be complimentary for all guests (no charge). There was also a recommendation for staff to look into live streaming of the event for those unable to attend.

In addition, Ms. Houghton reported that the Foundation is collaborating with the Scholarship Foundation of Santa Barbara to host their annual scholarship ceremony for north county students on Tuesday, May 22, 2018. The event would be held in the gym allowing for possible cost sharing of some rentals and the opportunity for graduating high school seniors/AHC students to be on the campus for the event.

BACKGROUND

In January 2018, the AHC Foundation board approved the use of funds from the Patricia Boyd Trust to support the construction and execution of the College's planned Fine Arts Classroom Complex. The Foundation's Finance Committee was authorized to work with the District on a distribution schedule. At a special meeting on March 9, the Finance Committee authorized the disbursement of \$600,080 as the first installment. (\$50K from Northern Trust and \$550,080 from Morgan Stanley) Finance Committee Chair Glenn Owen asked the District to provide a tentative schedule for future disbursements so that staff could provide funds in a timely manner. The schedule is below

Two Boyd Funds remain: Northern Trust (approximately \$6 million) and Rabobank (approximately \$4 million). The Finance Committee will withdraw funds based upon the above schedule at a 60% (Northern Trust) and 40% (Rabobank) distribution schedule.

The document will be made available to all directors at the meeting for their signature.

Allan Hancock College Foundation Statement of Conduct, Commitment, and Conflict of Interest

As elected directors, appointees, officers, and staff of the Allan Hancock College Foundation, we represent a corporate body whose actions are in the interest of the public and thus have a clear obligation to conduct all affairs of the corporation in a manner consistent with this concept. The following statements, while not an exhaustive list of the standards, care, and practice in which this foundation should engage, shall serve as a guide upon which I will conduct myself in dealing with the matters before this corporation.

I AGREE:

- 1. To represent the foundation and perform such duties in good faith and in a manner believed to be in the best interest of the foundation with such care as would be exercised by ordinary prudent persons in a like position.
- 2. Carefully prepare for, attend and actively participate in board and committee meetings, using reasonable effort to ascertain all relevant facts and to develop a rational basis for believing every decision made by the board was done so in the best interest of the foundation.
- 3. Vote according to my conviction, avoiding a rubber-stamp syndrome. I will challenge the judgment of others when necessary, yet be willing to support the majority decision.
- 4. To refuse gifts, gratuities, favors or services of any kind from any person, firm or corporation doing business or seeking to do business with the foundation when it might be inferred that the purpose was to influence my objectivity.
- 5. To avoid the appearance of or actual taking of the opportunity for self-dealing. I will not allow the foundation to enter into transactions with entities in which I or certain directors have an interest if the transaction is deemed not to be in the best interests of the foundation.
- 6. To disclose in full to the Board of Directors any personal situation or position which would conflict, or might reasonably be supposed to conflict with my performance of corporate duties and responsibilities. Disclosure of a private or proprietary nature should be made to the board president who may report only to the Executive Committee of the Board.
- 7. To maintain the confidential nature of donor and donor prospect relationships and not divulge to others such confidential information or use such for personal or business gain or profit or to divulge such information to other non-profit organizations with which I may be involved.
- 8. To abide by and uphold the bylaws, articles of incorporation, policies and procedures of the foundation.
- 9. To be reasonable, honest, involved, and informed.

As non-district employees, Foundation staff members receive different types of benefits.

The current cash in lieu benefit is \$3,200 annually. It was last increased July 1, 2009. Prior increases were \$2370 (July 2007) and \$2282 (January 2005)

While there was a \$910 increase in this benefit amount over a period of four years (2005-2009), there has been no adjustment to reflect rising health care costs since 2009.

RECOMMENDATION

Provide an increase of Cash in Lieu benefit for Foundation employees to \$5000 annually, retroactive to January 1, 2018. Impact on the Foundation budget: \$7200 annually.

Direction to the Finance committee to review all other staff benefits and come up with a recommendation that supports the current needs of the Foundation and its employees.
