

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

STEP 1: APPLY FOR ADMISSION

Complete an **admission application** online at: <u>https://www.hancockcollege.edu/apply/cccapply.php</u>

Students will need to know the following:

- Their valid personal email address
- Social security number (if applicable)
- Permanent address (if applicable)
- Residential status incl. alien registration number, its issue and expiration dates (if applicable)

Students will:

- Create <u>OpenCCC account</u> with a unique username and password (**Step 1**)
- Submit an <u>admission application</u> for the correct term (Step 2)
- Receive an <u>AHC Student ID number</u> (also known as H number) via email
- Receive <u>AHC user name and log-in</u> <u>instructions to myHancock</u> portal via email

IMPORTANT!

Print or write down and keep in your records:

- OpenCCC user name and password
- AHC Student ID also known as H number
- Username and password to myHancock portal

STEP 2: COMPLETE PAPERWORK

Download and complete the following forms:

- <u>Concurrent Enrollment Petition for</u> Enrollment
- <u>Concurrent Enrollment Appeal</u> (if applicable) <u>Reasons for Appeal</u>:
 - o Low GPA at AHC
 - Enrolling in more than 6 units

G Signatures needed on paperwork:

- Student's
- Parent's or Guardian's
- High School Principal's or their Designee's

How to Sign the Forms

- Print, fill out, and sign
- Fill out electronically, print, collect signatures, and scan with a free smartphone app, such as *Simple Scanner, Adobe Scan, or CamScanner* or take a picture! Make sure the scan or picture is legible!
- Complete and sign the form electronically with Adobe Sign

Submit ALL completed forms to your school

NOTE: Incomplete paperwork will be returned to the high school designee and not processed. Hancock Student ID# is required on all forms!
