


Challenges Survey Results


Executive Summary

- The survey was sent via email RAVE system to students. A total of 219 students responded to the survey.
- The survey asked students about the challenges they have faced while attending at Allan Hancock College in five key areas: Financial aid, academic support services, coursework, accessing online services, and work and personal life.
- Challenges faced with financial aid are paying for college and living expenses (48%), working with the financial aid office (24%), and military veteran benefits (2%).
 - o Of the 105 students who responded that they had challenge paying for college and living expenses,
 - The most challenging expense was books (82%), following by living expenses (72%), transportation (50%), and tuition and fees (36%). The least challenging expense was childcare (10%).
 - Thirty-six percent of students said they had to withdraw from a class or not register due do challenges with expenses.
 - Of the 49 students who responded that they had a challenge with financial aid office,
 - the most challenging issue was the process was unclear (47%), experienced delays getting money (43%), had difficulty meeting with, speaking to, or emailing staff (35%), and had errors processing paperwork (31%).
 - Only 3 students responded they had an issue with military veteran's benefits so no further data was analyzed due to small sample size.
- Challenges faced with academic support services include registering for courses (21%), academic counseling (16%), tutoring (10%), and library and Academic Resource Center (8%).
 - o Of the 45 students who responded that they had a challenge with academic support services,
 - Students who experienced issues with academic counseling stated they had difficulty meeting with, speaking to or emailing counselor (35%), told to take course not needed (19%), or not told about a course needed (12%).
- Challenges faced with course work include transfer-level course work (18%) and developmental courses (17%).
- Challenges faced with work and personal life include work (40%), family and friends (39%), health and disability issues (34%), and transportation (25%).
- Twenty-three percent of students have challenges with online student services.




What types of expenses were challenging? Please check all that apply.

What issues did you have with the financial aid office? Please check all that apply.




What issues did you have with military veteran benefits? Please check all that apply.




Have you had any challenges with academic support services?




What challenges did you have with academic counseling? Please check all that apply.




What issues did you have registering for courses? Please check all that apply.






Have you faced any challenges in your course work?



What issues did you have with developmental courses? Please check all that apply.




What issues did you have with transfer-level courses? Please check all that apply.



Have you had any challenges accessing online student services?










What health and disability issues did you have? Please check all that apply.










How available were Counseling staff when you interacted with them?



How concerned were Counseling staff about addressing your issue?




How effective were Counseling staff when addressing your issue?




Have you contacted or interacted with Admissions and Records during this semester?




How available were Admissions and Records staff when you interacted with them?



How concerned were Admissions and Records staff about addressing your issue?




How effective were Admissions and Records staff when addressing your issue?






How available were Financial Aid staff when you interacted with them?



How concerned were Financial Aid staff about addressing your issue?




How effective were Financial Aid staff when addressing your issue?




Have you contacted or interacted with Learning Assistance Program during this semester?




How available were Learning Assistance Program staff when you interacted with them?



How concerned were Learning Assistance Program staff about addressing your issue?








Considering the overall value of the education you have received so far from Allan Hancock College, is it ...




What is your purpose for taking courses at Allan Hancock College? Please choose the response that best fits your purpose.




How well is your education at Allan Hancock College helping you improve yourself?




How well is your education at Allan Hancock College increasing your job and career opportunities?



How well is your education at Allan Hancock College preparing you for an associate's degree?




How well is your education at Allan Hancock College preparing you for transfer to a fouryear university?




What is your primary campus (where do you take most of your classes)?






Thinking about the current semester, are you currently enrolled full-time or part-time?




When are your classes this semester? Please check all that apply.
