FIRST YEAR CHECKLIST: ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-2026

1 COMPLETE THE ONLINE ADMISSION APPLICATION

Starting October 1, 2024

1a. Going to college is MAJOR... do you know yours? When completing the AHC admissions application, you will be asked to select a major. This is the area of study you will focus on that will lead to your future career. You want to be sure to select one aligned with your interests and career goals. If you need help deciding, take the short career quiz and/ or browse our Areas of Interest on our website before you apply at hancockcollege.edu/pathways/quiz.php.

1b. Visit hancockcollege.edu/apply/cccaply.php to get started. Select summer 2025. Redo this process again for fall 2025.

To complete the application, you will need:

- A copy of your current high school transcript. Placement for math and English is based on your high school GPA.
- Your Social Security Number or permanent resident card. If you do not have either, leave this section of the application blank.
- Your chosen major at AHC. Visit our Areas of Interest webpage at hancockcollege.edu/pathways/ for a list of our current associate degrees, transfer degrees, and certificates.
- An email address (please do not use your high school email address). If you or your parents do not have an email address, please sign up for one at yahoo.com or gmail.com before you get started.

Your AHC student ID (H#) and your username will be sent to the email address that you used to apply within 24-36 hours. Be sure to keep both of these in a safe place. Your AHC student ID (H#) will be used throughout your time at AHC.

2 COMPLETE THE ONLINE FAFSA OR DREAM ACT APPLICATION

Starting December 2024

To ensure that you are considered for the maximum federal and state financial aid grants do not wait to file your financial aid application! The priority deadline is March 2, 2025 (date is subject to change).

Attend a Cash for College event to receive assistance in completing either application.

- Complete the FAFSA, visit fafsa.gov OR complete the CA Dream Act, visit dream.csac.ca.gov
- Find and attend a Cash for College workshop at a location convenient for you at hancockcollege.edu/calsoap

To complete either application, you will need the following if applicable:

- Student & Parent/Adoptive Parents' Social Security Number (SSN) if you have one
- Student & Parent/Adoptive Parents' 2023 W-2's & 2023 tax returns
- Student & Parent/Adoptive Parents' records of untaxed income such as welfare benefits, SS benefits, or child support payments
- Student & Parent/Adoptive Parents' birthdates
- Student & Parent/Adoptive Parents' personal email address

3 COMPLETE ORIENTATION

Starting November 2024

- Using your assigned username e-mailed to you in step 1b from your admission application, login to your myHancock portal and select New Student Orientation to complete your orientation online.

4 ATTEND PROMISE REGISTRATION RALLY

Starting May 1, 2025

Students can choose to follow path 4a OR 4b:

4a- Seniors attending Promise Registration Rally:

- Attend a Launch to College event at your high school to complete a first-semester plan.
- High school seniors who complete Promise Steps 1-3 by April 18, 2025, will be invited to attend our Promise Registration Rally on May 1, 2025 happening at your school site and register for summer and/or fall classes the same day.

4b- Seniors completing registration on their own:

- Students unable to attend a Launch to College event and/or the Promise Registration Rally will need to complete the following steps to register for courses during priority registration:
 1. Complete a first semester plan with an AHC counselor before Friday, April 18, 2025. Priority registration begins Thursday, May 1, 2025. 805-922-6966 ext. 3293

2. Go to hancockcollege.edu and log in to your myHancock portal
3. Scroll down to "Register Add/Drop Classes"
4. When you register, have your first semester education plan (SEP) available. If you need a copy, you can obtain one by logging into myHancock portal and clicking on "Degree Works".
5. You **MUST** register for a minimum of 12 units for fall 2025 AND spring 2026 semesters. There is NO minimum-unit requirement if you attend summer 2025.
6. You **MUST** register and complete one English and one math class during the summer, fall, or spring semester, if required by your program of study (major).

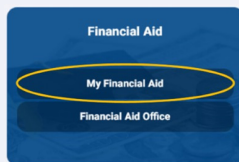
While we highly encourage students to attend the registration event, students who are unable to attend the Promise Registration Rally can visit the Admissions and Records website to review Steps to Enrollment: hancockcollege.edu/apply/register.php

Priority registration for Promise students is only available upon completion of steps 1-3 AND creation of a first semester plan.

Congratulations! You have completed steps 1-4. You are now a Hancock Promise student!

CHECK YOUR FINANCIAL AID STATUS AFTER YOU REGISTER

- Go to hancockcollege.edu and log in to your **myHancock portal**
- Scroll to the "Financial Aid" button and click **"My Financial Aid"**
- Choose the Award Year: **"Summer 2025 to Spring 2026."** You will see your unsatisfied requirement/documents.



- If you have a Financial Aid Task (unsatisfied requirements), you will need to create an account before you can continue. Use your last name, as reported on your FAFSA when creating your account.
- Double click on each of the required items and complete each task/document listed. You may need to print, scan, and upload to submit these documents. If you are unable to upload, email the completed and signed documents to finaid@hancockcollege.edu.

Complete and submit all of the required documents before you can be awarded any additional financial aid grants.

Students will receive a notification to their myHancock email about steps to complete. These steps, including any requested documents, must be completed before students can receive any financial aid funds. The priority deadline to complete your financial aid file for summer 2025 students is **May 23, 2025**. The priority deadline to complete your financial aid file for fall 2025 students is **July 25, 2025**. For questions, call the Financial Aid office at 805-922-6966 ext. 3200.

5 COMPLETE A COMPREHENSIVE STUDENT EDUCATION PLAN (SEP)

May - October 2025

- You will need to have this completed before registration begins for the spring 2026 semester, which is usually in early November. We strongly encourage students to complete all Hancock Promise steps no later than the start of fall 2025.

The priority timelines shown above have been developed to ensure that students have maximum access to priority registration services at AHC for summer & fall 2025. Completion of these steps after the priority timelines will still be accepted and processed on a first-come, first-serve basis through May 2026.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Enroll at AHC immediately after graduating from high school (includes public, charter, private or home schools) **OR** adult schools located within the AHJCC district.

- Complete the FAFSA or CDAA.
- Register and complete a minimum of 12 units in both fall and spring semesters. There is NO minimum unit requirement if you attend summer school.
- Maintain a 2.0 grade point average in the fall semester in order to be eligible for the Promise in the spring semester.
- Complete one English and one math class during the summer/fall 2025 or spring 2026 semesters at AHC, if required by the program of study.

1 AM I ELIGIBLE?

Students should review these eligibility requirements carefully to ensure they are eligible for the second year of the Hancock Promise. If there are questions about eligibility, please contact Hancock Promise by e-mail at promise@hancockcollege.edu or by phone at 805-922-6966 ext. 3264. You can also text your question to 805-849-2349.

- 1. Completed English 101 with a "C" grade or better*
- 2. Completed a 100 level 3-unit math course with a "C" grade or better*
- 3. Completed 24 or more units**
- 4. Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 by the end of the spring 2026 semester.
- 5. Completed a Comprehensive Student Education Plan (CSEP)
- 6. Submitted a 2025-2026 FAFSA/CADAA

* Students who are enrolled in a certificate program that does NOT require math or English will be exempt from the Math and English Requirement. (The student must have a CSEP on file and be following the courses required for the certificate program to maintain exemption.)

** Students who complete math and English by the end of summer 2026 may appeal to the Dean of Student Services to have their Promise Year 2 award starting with the Fall semester.

Items 1 through 4 must be completed no later than the end of spring 2026. Students should complete their CSEP and their application for financial aid no later than July 31, 2026.

2 COMPLETE A COMPREHENSIVE STUDENT EDUCATION PLAN

Starting May 2025

- Complete your Comprehensive Student Education Plan (CSEP) by July 31, 2026.**

A comprehensive SEP is a semester-by-semester plan created with an AHC counselor listing all the courses you will need to reach your educational goal.

3 COMPLETE THE ONLINE FAFSA OR DREAM ACT APPLICATION Starting November 2025

To ensure that you are considered for the maximum state financial aid grants, you **MUST** apply for financial aid by Monday, March 2, 2026.

Attend a Cash for College event to receive assistance in completing either application.

- Complete the FAFSA, visit fafsa.gov OR complete the CA Dream Act, visit dream.csac.ca.gov
- Find and attend a Cash for College workshop at a location convenient for you at hancockcollege.edu/calsoap

4 REGISTER FOR SUMMER/FALL 2026 Starting early April 2026

1. Class search opens early April. Registration opens late April for summer and fall semesters.
CLASSES FILL QUICKLY SO REGISTER EARLY!
2. Check My Registration Date on myHancock under the "Registration" tab for your registration date.
3. When you register, refer to your comprehensive student education plan (CSEP) which can be found in Degree Works in your "Plans" tab.

Promise Reminders:

You must register for at least 12 units each semester, both fall and spring. Although not required, we strongly recommend you register for summer courses as well. All summer and winter courses are covered by the Hancock Promise.

5 REVIEW YOUR ELIGIBILITY TO GRADUATE/TRANSFER Starting September 2026

- Students interested in applying to transfer should begin visiting the **University Transfer Center** in **EARLY FALL 2026** to ask about application timelines.
Each school and university has their own requirements depending on the major, so meeting with a counselor is necessary to ensure you have met all transfer requirements.
- Students intending to graduate in May 2027 should meet with a counselor in **EARLY FALL 2026** to ensure they are meeting all AHC graduation requirements.
